





The Orkney Sailing Club building is known as the Girnel and dates from 1640 when it was a store for the island's grain. In those days rents due to the landlord were paid in goods produced on the crofts. Grains such as oats, bere and malt were the most common commodity used to pay the annual rents. Tenants from the North Isles delivered their payments to Kirkwall, landing at the Corn Slip, opposite the Girnel. The grain was collected, stored and shipped to the Scottish Mainland where it was sold for cash which the landlord kept.

In 1972 the Orkney Sailing Club, based in Kirkwall, had developed sufficiently to warrant a headquarters of their own. After much fund raising the building was purchased and has proved to be a popular and successful facility.

The building was recently renovated with help from Historic Scotland. All original external features and building methods were maintained. Orkney Sailing Club now provides facilities among the best in the North of Scotland.



Facilities in the club house include:

Lounge Bar with Pool Table Free Wi-Fi Internet access Toilets, Showers (Keys held by Marina Staff and Harbour Masters Office).
